the General Meeting Working Group has been trying very hard to find a workable solution to implementing the Board resolution to put motions by postal ballot.

Directors will have received the email from David Taplin stating that TBT are unable to act for DTE in any form of postal ballot including one entirely using Election Buddy, having regard to the current movement restrictions in force.

We have also been advised by the Business Victoria section of the Victorian Government that travel permits will not be entertained for any activity regarding organisational voting.

Can any Director advise of any mechanism to implement the Board's GM ballot resolution?

If no workable solution is proposed, we believe it is everybody's best interest for the Board to urgently rescind its motion for postal ballots, in order to allow the upcoming SGM proceed without dispute around this matter.
